

Tuition Fee Schedule for the School Year 2017/18 for the International German School of Brussels

1. Admission Fee

The admission fee per student amounts to:

Bilingual Preschool (BVS)	€750.00
Primary School	€1,000.00
Secondary School	€1,000.00

The admission fee is reduced by 50% from the third child on. Thus, the admission fees for the third and each following child amount to:

- €375.00 for bilingual preschool
- €500.00 for primary and secondary school

The reduction applies to all parents ("Self-funded", "Partially self-funded", funded by employer").

2. Tuition

The tuition per student amounts to:

*The open afternoon planning ensures that each child takes part in one activity each afternoon.

The tuition fee is reduced by 25% for the first year upon request for (partial) self-payers (for partial self-payers, this applies only to amount paid by them).

The (partial) self-payer status must be verified (generally by the employer).

3. Extras

Any costs which occur for the large school trips in addition to the tuition fees are billed by contractual partners (i.e. it is not possible to make out invoices to businesses). Other expenses, such as for the yearbook, the school shirt, the homework diary, or literature which is covered in the lessons, are included in the tuition.

4. German as a Second Language/Foreign Language (GSL/GFL)

To facilitate the linguistic integration of the students whose first language is not German, the iDSB offers a wide range of support programs. For BVS and Primary School, the children with language support needs are classified into small support groups with the help of the school's own linguistic assessments.

For BVS children (Kindergarten and preschool children), four support hours are offered per week in small groups. The costs for the parents amount to €40.00 per week. For the students in primary school in grades 1-4, a two-hour core support programme as well as an extra cost-intensive support programme in small groups over four hours per week is offered. The costs for the parents amount to €50.00 per week. For students in secondary school, two support program hours per week are funded by the school in the first support year. After a consultation session, parents can take advantage of up to 2 additional support hours per week at a price of €50.00 each.

The school decides over the amount and need of support hours or intensive language support at the time of student registration. Further individual solutions are possible. The costs for the supplementary language instruction after the first support year are to be borne completely by the parents. The charges for supplementary language instruction are included in the tuition fee billing.

5. Canteen

For BVS and Primary School, the meals from the canteen must be booked at the start of a semester (half year). The registration for participation in canteen meals can be done via the online portal of the iDSB website. The secondary school students can continue to use their PingPing cards in the canteen. The individual price for a secondary school student is €5.30.

6. Social rebates

(Partial) self-payers have the option of applying for a sibling and loyalty rebate.

- The sibling rebate is 25% for the second child and 45% for each additional child.
- The loyalty rebate for all children which are registered at iDSB for longer than three years is 20%.

Sibling and loyalty rebates can be combined if the respective requirements are fulfilled. The rebates will come into effect starting at the next billing month after receipt of the application.

Anyone who pays the tuition fees from their own resources, without directly or indirectly receiving reimbursement of the tuition fees from their employer, is considered a self-payer. The determining factor is not who pays the invoice, but if the parents are reimbursed for the tuition fees or not, either directly or upon request.

If parents receive a reimbursement that partly covers the tuition costs, these parents are considered partially self-paying. The amount of the repayment is specified in the application. The sibling and loyalty rebates for partial self-payers apply to the amount that these parents pay from their own resources. The sibling rebates are only granted once the tuition fees for at least one child are to be borne by the parents.

Parents that are reimbursed the tuition fees for children attending the Primary School or Secondary School but pay the fees from their own resources for children attending the BVS are counted as self-paying regarding the BVS. In this case the sibling rebate is only granted for children attending the BVS, whereby only children in the BVS are counted when the numbers of siblings are determined.

Furthermore, self-payers can also apply for a social rebate under specific conditions. The application plausibility of the application is verified by the administration. For this purpose, the applicant(s) must specify some key information regarding their financial situation, based on which the social committee of the school association then decides on a possible reduction.

Social rebates are not granted for BVS attendance.

If the application proves to be false, in particular if the preconditions of self-payer or partial self-payer status prove to be inaccurate from the submission of the application and anytime thereafter, the wrongfully granted rebate is to be paid back to the

school without delay. Any changes which occur during the time that the rebate is active are to be reported to the administration immediately and without being prompted.

7. Payment details

Company payers will receive an annual bill at the start of the school year. (Partial) self-payers will also receive an annual bill, but have the option to pay the tuition fees monthly in 10 instalments (September 2017 to June 2018) at the start of each month.
