I would like to take this opportunity to say a big thank you to the helpers involved, Ms Petersen, Ms Gutermuth and Ms Mejia, and to our colleagues, especially Dr Wernig and the class teachers Ms Weber and Ms Krüger for their support!

And also a big thank you to Mrs van den Beukel, our Head of Administration, who is very committed to the social engagement of the iDSB. She worked hard to ensure that the school was able to donate the food distributed.

The project will take place on a regular basis, this term once again with the two sixth form classes.

Do you already know our school radio club?


