## International History Bee & Bowl - Returning in 2026!

After a highly successful inaugural year, we are delighted to announce that the **International History Bee and Bowl of Benelux** is returning to the International German School of Brussels on **Saturday, 7 February 2026**.

Following the strong participation and positive feedback in 2025, the tournament continues to grow and attract increasing international attention. This year, we are especially excited to welcome a school from Luxembourg and another all the way from Lithuania! This expansion highlights the growing profile of the Benelux tournament as a truly international academic event.

For those who are new to the event, the International History Bee & Bowl is a fast-paced, buzzer-based history competition conducted entirely in English. Open to students of all experience levels, it offers an engaging and intellectually challenging environment that promotes critical thinking, teamwork, and a deeper appreciation of global history.

Top-performing students and teams will qualify for the European Championships, which will take place in Berlin in mid-2026.


### **Use the mobile version of phidias**
